

THE WESTBURY HOTEL

DUBLIN, IRELAND



Among the collection at the **Westbury** in Dublin are several pieces by native son Patrick Scott. Best known for his *gold paintings*, abstracts incorporating geometrical forms in gold leaf against a pale tempera background, he originally trained as an architect.

Three of his works are featured in the Grafton Suite Lobby – *Flame Device*, *White Foam* and *Orange Device*. His paintings are also in several important collections including the Museum of Modern Art in New York. Other 20th-century and contemporary artists on display in The Gallery of the hotel are landscape painter Norah McGuinness, figurative painter Michael Kane, abstract expressionist Barrie Cooke, and romantic painter Daniel O'Neill.
