celebrates the children's author and illustrator with a number of special displays about her life and work. *Beatrix Potter's London*, on display this summer, will bring together artworks, original sketches and Potter's earliest published works to look at the role London played throughout her career. The V&A holds the world's largest collection of Beatrix Potter's drawings, literary manuscripts, correspondence, photographs and related materials, and hosts a regularly changing display on particular aspects of her work. The V&A's connection with Beatrix Potter began during the author's lifetime. Although Potter is often associated with the sweeping landscapes of Scotland and the Lake District depicted in her illustrations, she actually spent most of her life at her family home at 2 Bolton Gardens in South Kensington and frequently visited the museums nearby.
