- Dedicated hotel green/sustainability team with a sustainability zone to communicate with the team.

- All new products are ethically sourced, and sustainability is a major consideration when selecting supply partners.
- Complimentary blue badge walking tour available (for a minimum of 6 guests and it must pre-booked in advance).
