THE STAGE FOR A NEW CONVERSATION IN LONDON'S LITERARY HEARTLAND


Located close to London's West End - home to Theatreland, Covent Garden and Soho - The Bloomsbury sits at the heart of the historic 18th century neighbourhood of the same name.

This rich heritage is reflected in the restored Grade II-listed neo-Georgian architecture of the imposing hotel. Designed in the 1930s by Sir Edwin Lutyens, the greatest British architect of his time, signature features include a magnificent stone frontage, stunning double-height bar and Lutyens-designed ironwork.

A recent transformation makes for an even more spectacular aesthetic, with the relocation of the entrance to the side of the hotel, via its own private lane and into a new Lutyensinfluenced sitting room complete with heritage-inspired botanical wallpaper.


